POSITION SUMMARY

The Truck and Coach Apprentice-Mechanic is responsible for maintaining, repairing, and overhauling the fleet of Plow/Sander trucks under the guidance of a certified mechanic. The Truck and Coach Apprentice-Mechanic functions within legislative requirements, regulations, policies and procedures and the Mission, Beliefs, and Visions of the Garden River First Nation, and contributes to the accomplishment of the strategic priorities

DUTIES

Maintain, repair, and overhaul our fleet of Plow/Sand Trucks and Industrial Heavy Equipment:

- Internal combustion engines and components
- Preventative maintenance on-highway and motor vehicles
- Interpret work orders and technical manuals
- Keep equipment clean, lubricated, and maintained
- Diagnose faults and malfunctions
- Adjust equipment, repair and/or replace defective parts, components, or systems
- Test repaired equipment for performance and ensuring it meets manufacturers' specifications and legislated requirements

To be successful in the trade, an Apprentice Mechanic must possess:

- Good understanding of Health and Safety at the workplace and the overall wellness and lifestyle decision
- Fluent and concise reading, writing, and speaking communication skills in English
- Ability to work alone and with team
- Good vision, hearing and sense of smell to diagnose problems
- Must have strength and stamina to work with heavy components in cramped and awkward positions
- Knowledge of preventive maintenance practises and inspection criteria
- The ability to think logically and keep up with the changes in technology
- Ability to execute work within standard repair times
- Performing other duties as may be required or assigned

- High School Diploma or Equivalent
- Preferred 1 year experience as an automotive technician or mechanic experience
- 1-2 or 3-year mechanic apprentice
- Motive Power Fundamentals – Heavy Equipment and Truck Repair considered a plus
- Valid Class G Drivers License and good driving records (Class D or D/Z considered an asset)
- Must have own tools (Basic set), provide safety equipment including goggles, steel toe safety boots and hardhats
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively as a member of the team
- Ability to consistent and display a positive/helpful attitude

- Willingness to accept changes in work practises and technology
- High degree of attention to detail; Ability to work under pressure to meet deadlines
